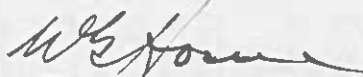

4- Creating commission of Civillian Defense, providing for the membership thereof and the duties thereof.

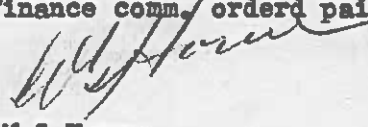
Corp. Council Howe stated other ordinances were being typed and should be read y by next meeting.
