Alderman Shaffer, Disaster comm. reported County Defense Director had resigned and the new Director would have a meeting soon giving instructions and assignments to the different committee men.

Also stated the Disaster committee on the Isle of Palms would have at least one fireman on the disaster committee.

A motion by Chm. Shaffer of the playground committee that the City advance \$100.00 to the playground committee secured by Alderman Anderson money to be used for Insurance to cover all accidents etc, of all activities on the playgrounds. Motion was unanimously carried.

Fire Comm. Chief Ghaconas stated the Fire Chiefs meeting to be held in Charleston Fire Protection week at College Park, and asked that demonstrations be held for the Isle of Palms, Sullivan's Island and Mt Pleasant be held on Isle of Palms during the Charleston week.

The Council was informed that the Mayors from Isle of Palms, Sullivan's Island and Mt. Pleasant also Dr. George Durst would meet with the County Delegation and Mr. McMillan and ask that the Copper River Bridge be speeded up. Alderman Hamer asked that the barricade at 41st. street be repaired.

The regular meeting of the City Council of Isle of Palms, May 13, 1959. Mayor Sottile presided. Meeting opened with prayer *Read* by Mayor Sottile.

Roll call: following present, Mayor Sottile, Mayor Pro Tem Lempesis, Alderman Anderson, Chaconas, Hamer, Holman, Lamb, Rumph and Shaffer, and Hopp. Counsellor Brummer.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. Regular order of business suspended ^{to} receive report from chairman of Police Committee and introduction of new patrolman given. *Leonard Patrick Gay.*

Alderman Lempesis stated Gay & Woodberry would work and split the hours at salary of \$1.00 per hour. Mayor Sottile gave the usual oath of office to Mr. Gay. Mr. Gay was appointed after unanimous approval of the Council.

Alderman Holman asked that some action be taken in regards to the handling of dogs.

Letter read from Mutual Insurance Company and Clerk instructed to refer letter to Corp. Counsellor for information.

Alderman Lempesis made a motion, 2nd by Alderman Rumph, that a Chevrolet Auto be purchased at the price given by Ft. Sumter Chevrolet Co, \$1490.00 plus old car and a few necessary additions. Motion carried unanimously.

A fee of \$50.00 to rename type of tax instead of dance hall. *discussed* Action postponed.

Uniform for extra policeman authorized by unanimous vote of Council.

Chairman of beach patrol Hamer was authorized to hire 5 lifeguards, 4 at 75 cents per hour and one at 90 cents per hour. Also order a first aid kit, 4 umbrellas, 2 bathing suits for each lifeguard. Also to have name; Isle of Palms Lifeguard put on shirts. Alderman Hamer asked that some way be arranged to have the beach cleaned off with rakes if possible. He will place 4 stands on beach for lifeguards. The extra one to go on 25th St. Alderman Hamer's lifeguard program approved unanimously.

Alderman Shaffer read a letter from Mr. Frank Sottile stating property improvements on playground and wished to express the appreciation for the good work of Mr. Graham and Mr. Mazyck and Mr. John Sottile. A motion made that engraved resolution and certificate of merit be presented to prominent workers on improvement of playground. This motion referred to special committee, Alderman Lempesis, Hamer, Lamb and Shaffer. Clerk asked to get Social Security number and so forth from each man working on electrical work at playground.
