## Application for Use of Specific Animal Permit

Upon application to and prior approval by the City's Police Chief, an owner may show, exhibit, or provide rides on for entertainment, a horse, pony, mule, donkey or other similar animal at such locations and for such duration as the Police Chief, in his discretion, deems reasonable under the circumstances then and there prevailing provided, however, that no such animal shall be kept, stabled, sheltered or corralled overnight within the City limits nor shall any person ride or cause to be ridden any such animal on the streets of the City or on the beaches. While in the City limits with the appropriate permit from the Police Chief, all such animals shall be maintained by their keeper in a clean and sanitary condition so that the animals do not give offense to other people in the vicinity, constitute a risk to public health or constitute a public nuisance. This application complies with the City of Isle of Palms Ordinance 6-2-3 (b).
